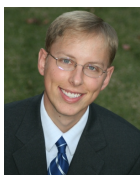

HOW WE CAN HELP YOUR CHURCH



As the executive director of Religious Affections Ministries, **SCOTT ANIOL** speaks regularly around the country on the topics of worship, music, culture, and aesthetics. Scott has degrees in church music and musicology and is pursuing a master's degree in theology.

SEVERAL SPEAKING OPTIONS

Scott is available to speak in your church or direct a choir clinic. Here are a few of the ways churches have used Scott's ministry:

SUNDAY

Scott can speak in **Sunday School and both services**. He typically presents the following messages (or pastors can choose any sessions from the list on back):

- SS: "Does Music Matter?"
- AM: "Is the Bible Enough?"
- PM: "Why Do We Sing in Church?"

WEEKEND

Scott is available for a full weekend. He can hold a **choir clinic** or teach sessions for your church musicians, including the following:

- "What is Congregational Worship?"
- "Qualifications for Church Musicians"
- "Preparation and Participation in the Worship Service"

SOUND WORSHIP CONFERENCE

Scott can present **6 sessions** to your congregation, either over a weekend or for part of the week (Sunday - Wednesday). He preaches the three messages listed under "Sunday" above plus the following 3 sessions:

- "How Should We Evaluate Musical Communication?"
- "Is Beauty in the Eye of the Beholder?"
- "How Should We Think About Sunday Morning?"

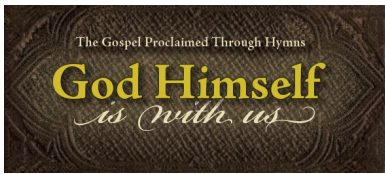

SACRED CONCERT

Scott and his wife Becky regularly present sacred concerts, introducing hymns in church services and conferences. They are currently presenting the gospel through the concert, “God Himself Is With Us.”



The hymn service consists simply of Scott and Becky singing arrangements of hymns accompanied by piano and string quartet (depending upon availability). Each hymn, with transitions of Scripture readings, progressively proclaims the gospel of Jesus Christ to save sinners. On several occasions, Scott leads the congregation on the final stanza of the hymn.
